

e-Frame Environmental Indicators Workshop

Venice, December 5th-6th, 2013

Save the date and Call for posters

Deadline for registrations and submissions: 30 September 2013

Dear e-Frame Partners,

We are pleased to announce that the e-Frame Workshop on Environmental Indicators will be held on December 5th-6th, 2013, in Venice-Italy, at the [FEEM headquarters](#) (Island of San Giorgio Maggiore, just in front of Saint Mark's Square). The event is organized by FEEM, in cooperation with the University of Siena.

The Environmental Indicators' Workshop aims to give an overview of the current state of the art of Environmental Indicators, presenting drawbacks of the past approaches, strengths of new methodologies and technical challenges ahead. It is structured into three thematic sessions. The first focuses on the technicalities in constructing Environmental Indicators; the second analyses Environmental Indicators as part of an integrated economic-environmental account and of the natural capital concept. The final session explores Environmental Indicators in the wider dimension of policy evaluation and policy making.

A poster session with the title "Theory and practice of Environmental Indicators: selection, construction, measurement and use issues" will be organized in addition to keynote presentations offered by reputed international experts. Researchers interested in presenting their work in the poster session are invited to submit the title and a short abstract (maximum 300 words) by email to elena.ferro@feem.it.

Deadline for submission of poster title and short abstract is **September 30th, 2013**.

Notification of acceptance will be sent by October 31st, 2013.

There is no registration fee for this workshop. It should be stressed that all participants are required to cover their own costs for travel, hotel and other expenses, as the organizers cannot provide any funding. FEEM will cover coffee breaks, lunches and a social dinner.

We have provisionally reserved a number of single rooms at the [Vittore Branca Residence](#) with check in December 4th and check out December 7th. This guesthouse is located just at a few steps from the entrance of FEEM, the meeting venue. The guesthouse is new and each room features a private bathroom and self catering facilities. Please find attached a description of the residence. The cost of the rooms are: 70 Euro per night for a single room, 120 Euro for a double room, 90 Euro for a double room to be used as single (in case single rooms are not available) including taxes and a small breakfast. The minimum stay is 2 nights. You will be asked to pay your stay in advance and inform about your arrival time. After this date, our preliminary reservation will be released.

Should the guesthouse not meet your needs, or should you wish to stay less than 2 nights, please find attached a list of suggested hotels in Venice.

We hope that representatives from your institution will be able to attend. Nonetheless, please kindly consider that limited places are available. On average we allow the participation of 2 members per partner, with a certain range of flexibility.

We kindly ask you to give us a follow up on your participation by **September 30th, 2013** by replying to this note.
